Kantonsschule Zürcher Unterland is the grammar school in the Zurich Lowlands. KZU offers a full grammar school (starting after primary school), as well as all the existing grammar school profiles: classical languages, mathematics and science, modern languages, arts, economy and law.

The school was founded in 1972, the present-day premises date back to 1975. They are located on the eastern fringe of the town of Bulach and comprise a beautiful campus and excellent sports facilities. The school buildings include two teaching wings, a great hall, a refectory and four gymnastics halls, as well as an underground parking lot.

KZU can be reached by bus or on foot from Bulach railway station.

Some 1100 people frequent the school on a daily basis: Over 900 students, 150 teachers, 30 staff.
